

WHAT IS A COVENANT?

A covenant is an agreement that participants promise to stick to. The Bible teaches us about
covenants between God and God's people, with the most important being God's promise to
send Jesus as our Savior. We call this the 'New Covenant.'
 Today, the most common covenant we see is the covenant of marriage when a man and woman
promise to love, honor, and cherish one another forever. The Kids Worship Team has a covenant
that all members promise to fulfill so together we can lead other kids in worship well.

KIDS WORSHIP TEAM COVENANT. Members will:

- ⇒ Live for Jesus
- ➤ Know that 'Worship is giving God our full attention. Because God alone is worthy of praise.'
- → Fulfill their chosen role to the best of their ability each week they are present and choose to lead during large group worship.

- → LIVE FOR JESUS: The church is full of people who believe in Jesus as their Lord and Savior. An important part of believing in Jesus is living your life in a way that shares Jesus' love and light with everyone you meet. How does serving on this team help you live for Jesus?
- ➡ WHAT IS WORSHIP? Worshipping God means that we focus on God, and praise (or celebrate) how awesome God is. We know God deserves praise because of who God is and all the amazing things he has done that we read about in the Bible and hear about from others. We worship in many ways: praying, singing, sitting, reading, dancing, and more!
- → **ROLES:** Each team role is an opportunity for you to use your gifts to help other kids focus on God. Think about the uniqueness of each role. How does each role help others worship?
